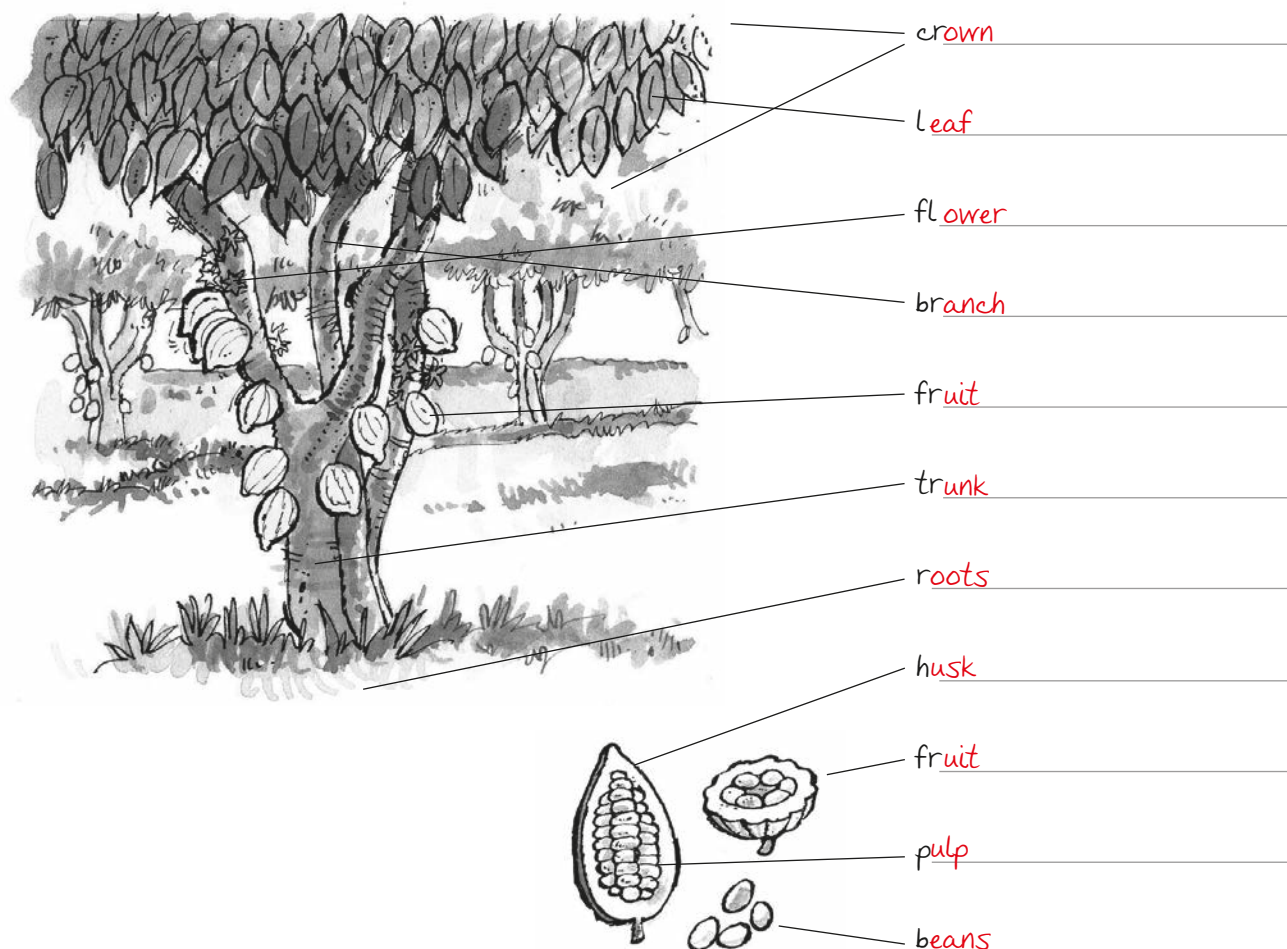




Label a cocoa tree

The cocoa tree

can grow as high as twelve metres. It has fruit that are more than 30 cm long. The tree often grows in the shade of other trees. The ripe fruit are many different colours: from brownish-yellow to orange. Flowers and fruit grow on the branches and the tree trunk. The flowers are white.

Each fruit contains 20 – 50 soft, white cocoa beans in a pink, sweet-sour pulp. The cocoa tree produces fruit every six months. The beans are harvested and dried. The pinkish pulp can be eaten with a spoon.
